NEW WINTER EVENTS FORMAT

- **New, simplified winter events with an elevated level of play**
- Open application based on the team's history
- Chance to earn a place in the summer's USYS National Championships
- Chance to earn a place in the **NEW** National League Cup
- Two total events per gender -- each team plays in one event




NEW WINTER EVENTS FORMAT

THE BASICS

For each gender, winter events will feature 14U, 15U, 16U, 17U & 19U age groups. In each age group...

APPLICATION PROCESS**



**EACH TEAM PLAYS ONE EVENT.
20 PLAY IN NOVEMBER.
20 PLAY IN JANUARY.**



**EACH TEAM PLAYS 3 GAMES
OVER 3 DAYS (GROUP
PLAY FORMAT) AT EVENTS**



NEW WINTER EVENTS FORMAT

APPLICATION PROCESS

- National League teams only
- Premier 1 division winners -- both club-based and team-based -- are guaranteed acceptance & choice of event
- Remaining open spots are awarded based on the team's history of performance (all NL teams considered)

EVENT STRUCTURE AND GAMEPLAY

- Group play format -- each team plays three total games over three days
- Teams from team-based and club-based divisions are combined and play each other
- Teams earn 3 points for a win, 1 point for a draw, and 0 points for a loss
- Final standings in each four-team group determine which teams advance to the USYS National Championships or the **NEW NL Cup**










NOVEMBER EVENT

JANUARY EVENT


Five groups of 4 teams.



NEW WINTER EVENTS FORMAT

ADDITIONAL DETAILS

- The event fee for a National League winter event is \$2,200.
- The winter event fee covers the entry fee into the USYS National Championships should a team qualify.
 - Second-place teams advancing to The NL Cup Playoffs have a minimal fee that covers referees and admin
- Each event weekend includes 100 total teams
- The size of events leads to opportunities to collaborate with ODP, possible Tier 2 integration, etc.
- Avoids conflicts with over-used December dates and recruiting dead periods

LEAGUE IN-SEASON PATHWAY

WHY INTRODUCE THE NATIONAL LEAGUE CUP?

- Survey of club directors indicated 75.5% wanted a National League Cup to be established
- Club directors rated the importance of National League regional events as 4.22 out of 5, and they rated the importance of a postseason league event as 4.06 out of 5.
- Better localized college recruiting opportunities
- Survey of college coaches found that 53% of recruits are found locally (within 3 hours of institution)
- Format is clean and easy to understand for college coaches, club coaches, parents and players





NORTHEAST PLAYOFFS

Boys - 8 Teams (7 AQs, 1 WC)
Girls - 8 Teams (6 AQs, 2 WCs)

2 Groups of 4 - Winner of Each Group Advances

FINALS

8 Teams - Bracket Format

SOUTHWEST PLAYOFFS

Boys - 8 Teams (4 AQs, 4 WCs)
Girls - 8 Teams (5 AQs, 3 WCs)

2 Groups of 4 - Winner of Each Group Advances

SOUTHEAST PLAYOFFS

Boys - 8 Teams (6 AQs, 2 WCs)
Girls - 8 Teams (6 AQs, 2 WCs)

2 Groups of 4 - Winner of Each Group Advances

All events are 48 games per day, played on 12 fields over 4 time slots. Teams play 3 games in 3 days. The 13U age group is AQs only.



RECAPPING THE WILDCARD SELECTION PROCESS

- Wildcard teams come from the National League winter events
 - Top 10 overall teams in each age group from National League winter events qualify to the USYS National Championships
 - BOYS - seeds 11-20 (10 teams) are NL Cup wildcards
 - GIRLS - seeds 11-21 (11 teams) are NL Cup wildcards
- A geographically-seeded blind draw will determine wildcard team placement for Playoffs
- Wildcard spots not filled by winter events will come from league play or open application
- All teams in 13U age group come from league play (no winter events to pull from)
